To act on behalf of our members and the public as the authority with state government to secure licensure for the Electrology profession in New York State

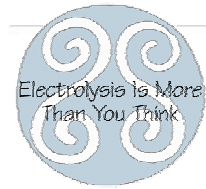

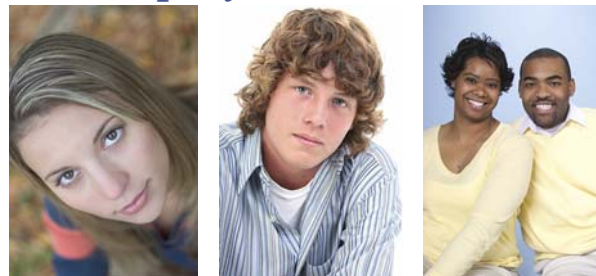

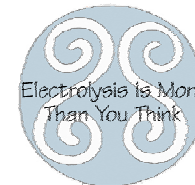
